## Parking problems?

## It is a huge inconvenience to have your driveway blocked by inconsiderate drivers.

If there is a Civil Enforcement Officer available in the area, you can request they issue a ticket to offending motorists parked on your driveway without your permission.

You will be asked to sign a document and the Civil Enforcement Officer will then issue a ticket to the vehicle blocking your driveway.

If you have no option other than driving to school, please be considerate of local residents and only park where it's safe to do so.

- Do not park in front of driveways if you do not have permission from the property owner.
- Do not park or drop children off where traffic regulations do not permit you to.
- Do not abuse Civil Enforcement Officers for doing their job and keeping your children safe.
- Do not drive to school unless necessary, or if you have to, park further away.
