Dear Parents,

The Governors and Senior Management Team would like to thank you for your continued support of Reddiford School.

We are pleased to inform you that there will be no increase in school fees for the academic year 2025-26. We are dedicated to the well-being and success of our pupils and remain committed to providing high-quality education and maintaining our standards of excellence while ensuring affordability for our families.

Fees will continue be inclusive of school trips/outings/innings (excluding any residential trips). Extra-curricular club prices will also be held in recognition that these now attract VAT. Wrap around care will be subject to a small increase to £8 per hour.

We have, once again, had a very successful year. Our Year 6 pupils have achieved outstanding results in their 11plus Entrance Examinations, successfully gaining offers at a wide range of prestigious Independent and Grammar Schools. We have also had an unprecedented number of scholarships offered to our pupils, including 34 academic scholarships and 10 Sports, Drama and Art scholarships.

Despite facing very significant cost pressures across all aspects of school life over the last few years, we remain committed to making our school fees affordable and competitive with other schools in the local area whilst retaining the excellent quality of education which the school is renowned for. The Governors are extremely mindful of their clear duty to ensure the long-term financial stability of Reddiford School and we continue to regularly review all expenditure ensuring value for money.

We acknowledge the sacrifices and efforts parents make to provide their children with the best possible education, and we want to assure you that our school remains steadfast in its mission to support our pupils academically, socially, and emotionally. By keeping our fees unchanged, we aim to ease financial pressures and reinforce our commitment to our school community.
