### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

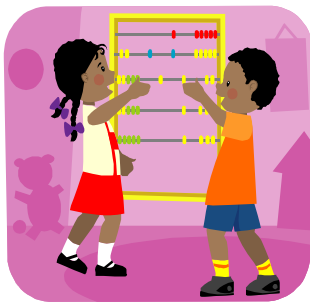
To look at the environment.
