Mathematics

To count, recognise and write numbers up to one hundred

To recognise number bonds up to ten then twenty.

To be able to count in twos, fives and tens.

To mentally add and subtract single digit numbers.

To be able to recognise numbers on a hundred square.

To use the correct vocabulary for length, weight, capacity, distance and money.

To learn about estimating and measuring.

To solve problems involving sharing, doubling and halving.

To begin to solve simple word problems.

To tell the time on the hour and half past the hour.

Expressive Arts & Design

To sing, dance and play musical instruments and prepare for the summer concert.

To explore colour, shape and texture through our topic work.

To learn how to use Modroc to make a minibeast.

To use their imagination when painting pebbles.

To take part in our summer concert.
